

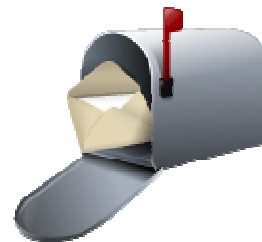

Keep Montgomery County Beautiful has established a Beautification Grant in order to promote volunteerism and community beautification within Montgomery County. There will be ten grants available to KMCB Adopt-An-Area groups, Community Pride Cleanup Supply Trailer groups, Day of Action/Make a Difference Day groups through the United Way, 501(c)3s, Montgomery County Solid Waste grant recipients, Habitat for Humanity projects and groups posting projects on the Volunteer Connection website. Maximum grant funding is \$250.00 to be used to purchase plants, bulbs, trees or shrubs for your project. You can help by cleaning an area of your choice (park, road, alley, neighborhood, playground, vacant lot, etc.) and we will provide the supplies you need to clean up or you can join an existing event:

- State Roadway Cleanup, March 27: Join the Ohio Department of Transportation and Keep Montgomery County Beautiful from 9:00 am to noon. Litter will be picked up on selected state roadways and highway entrance/exit ramps. Call 225-4999 or visit [www.mcswd.org](http://www.mcswd.org) to sign up now.
- City of Dayton, Southeast Priority Board Area Cleanup, April 24: Join us for Global Youth Service Day and help pick up litter. The event will run from 9:00 am to noon. Call 225-4999 for more information.
- Adopt-A-Park, April 17: Five Rivers MetroParks will be hosting this cleanup event from 9:00 am to noon. Anyone can volunteer by calling 937-275-7275.

- We provide trash bags from our national sponsor Glad®, gloves and possibly free litter disposal at our facilities.
- The Community Pride Cleanup Supply Trailer is available on a first come, first serve basis for groups of five or more people. Please check the [calendar of events](#) for Trailer availability. **Get More Information.**
- We can provide assistance in planning your event. We have announcement posters, event planning tips and possible assistance with picking up the trash bags. We can help you make your event a success.
